Young, anemic, malnourished mothers give birth to low-birth-weight malnourished babies. To address this problem, MLDT has implemented an integrated strategy to treat and prevent malnutrition and anemia by focusing for 1,000 days on the mother and 1,000 days on the child. Pregnant and lactating mothers are provided supplements and critical education to ensure good health of the mother and the child.
